Dear Mr. Widerburg:

Navajo Communications Company, Inc. d/b/a Frontier Navajo Communications Company hereby submits an electronic filing of revised tariff sheets, Exhibit A and a redline version of proposed tariff sheets, Exhibit B as required by Utah Administrative Code R746-405-2(D)(6).

The purpose of this filing is to change the Federal Lifeline Support Credit - Voice discount from \$5.25 to \$6.50 as a result of the FCC's Lifeline Modernization, WC Docket No. 11-42, Order No: FCC 16-38, issued April 27, 2016.

It is respectfully requested that this filing become effective on December 1, 2021.

The proposed tariff revisions do not constitute a violation of state law or PSC rule pursuant to Utah Administrative Code R746-405-2(D)(3)(g). We conclude, without prejudice to dissimilar conclusions in future filings, that in this instance these deficiencies are not material enough to be a basis to suspend or deny the tariff.

## **CONDITIONS**

Access Line Service (continued)

9. Enhanced Lifeline Service for Tribal Lands

Residential customers who reside on federally recognized tribal lands are eligible to receive additional enhanced federal Lifeline support in order to reduce the price for basic local telephone service. An individual living on tribal lands shall qualify for an additional enhanced federal Lifeline credit of up to \$25.00 per month if the individual participates in any state or federal programs identified in Section 4, Sheet 5, or in one of the following assistance programs:

- Bureau of Indian Affairs General Assistance
- Tribally Administered Temporary Assistance for Needy Families
- Head Start (only those households meeting its income qualifying standard)
- Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR)

If a resident of a federally recognized tribal land satisfies the state's Lifeline eligibility criteria as defined in Section 4, Sheet 2, the resident will receive the state support as well as the additional enhanced federal support.

The additional enhanced federal credit will be available to Lifeline customers who reside on tribal lands in the following exchanges:
