On November 5, 2021, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) issued an order (DA 21-1389) pausing the elimination of the federal Lifeline benefit for standalone voice service for one year. As a result, Lifeline customers subscribed only to voice service or voice with a non-qualifying broadband service will continue to receive the federal Lifeline benefit. Therefore, South Central Utah Telephone Association, Inc submits this filing to remove the \$0.00 Lifeline rate from the Lifeline Rates table and the associated footnote.
