The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed UBTA-UBET Communications Inc.'s ("UBTA-UBET") proposed revisions to Page Nos. 1-9, 11-13, 23, 26, 28-32, 34-37, 39-73, 75-78, 80, 83, 85, 90-91, 93, 95-97, 118-124, and 130-132 of its P.S.C.U. No. 1 Tariff ("Tariff"), filed on November 16, 2021. UBTA-UBET states that the purpose of this filing is to update service offerings, clean up outdated tariff sheets, and modify and consolidate rates. UBTA-UBET requests an effective date of December 16, 2021 for the proposed revisions.

The PSC also reviewed the comments of the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed on November 29, 2021. DPU concludes that the proposed revisions do not impact UBTA-UBET's service offerings, its overall revenue will be unchanged, and the proposed rate increases are just and reasonable. DPU also states that UBTA-UBET's Board of Directors approved the proposed revisions by mailed notice on November 1, 2021, with a public comment meeting on November 15, 2021. DPU states it has no objections to the proposed changes and recommends the PSC approve UBTA-UBET's proposed revisions to the Tariff with the requested effective date.

Based on the PSC's review of UBTA-UBET's filing and DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC approves UBTA-UBET's proposed revisions to its Tariff, as filed, effective December 16, 2021.
