Dear Mr. Rutkowski,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed All West Communications, Inc.'s ("All West") proposed revisions to Page Nos. 44, 87, and 208 of its PSC Utah No. 1 Tariff ("Tariff"), transmitted on May 28, 2021. The purpose of this filing is to comply with Federal Communications Commission amended rules that implement 8YY access charge reform.¹ This reform requires all rate-of-return incumbent local exchange carriers to modify originating 8YY rates in the following groups: End Office/Local Switching, Transport, and Query Charge. All West requests an effective date of July 1, 2021 for these changes.

The PSC also reviewed the comments of the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed on June 3, 2021. DPU states it has no objections to the proposed changes and recommends the PSC approve All West's proposed revisions to the Tariff with the requested effective date. According to DPU, the Tariff revisions are consistent with the FCC's 8YY Access Charge Reform Order.

Based on the PSC's review of All West's filing and DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC approves All West's proposed revisions to its Tariff, as filed, effective July 1, 2021.
