Re: **Docket No. 21-2543-01**, In the Matter of the Notification of Spectrotel, Inc. d/b/a OneTouch Communications d/b/a Touch Base Communications' Notice of Corporate Reorganization Creating a New Affiliate Spectrotel of the West LLC.

Recommendation (Approve)

The Division of Public Utilities ("Division") recommends that the Public Service Commission ("Commission") approve the notice of corporate reorganization and the creation of the new affiliate Spectrotel of the West, LLC ("Spectrotel West") and the transferring of the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") from Spectrotel, Inc. d/b/a OneTouch Communications d/b/a Touch Base Communications ("Spectrotel") to Spectrotel West.

The Division expects that, based on history that a filing of this type and with the information submitted by the company, there will be no objections or opposition to this recommendation. Therefore, the Division requests that this docket be adjudicated informally in accordance with R746-110-1.

Discussion

On or about February 01, 2021, Spectrotel filed a notice with the Commission indicating their company will be restructuring and adding a new affiliate to its organization.

Spectrotel is a privately held corporation organized under the laws of the State of Delaware. Headquartered at 3535 State Highway 66, Suite 7, Neptune, NJ 07753. Spectrotel was issued a CPCN on December 06, 2011 in Docket No. 11-2543-01.

Spectrotel West is a newly created privately held limited liability company organized under the laws of the State of Delaware. It is headquartered at the same location as Spectrotel.

Upon completion of the reorganization, Spectrotel request that the Commission transfer its CPCN, certificate no. 2543, to the new affiliate Spectrotel West. Spectrotel states that there will be no change to the management, corporate ownership, rates, and or services. Because it is an internal corporate restructuring the restructuring will be transparent to customers.

Conclusion

The Division has reviewed the notice filed by Spectrotel for the reorganization and transfer of its certificate to its affiliate Spectrotel West and concludes it is in the public interest; therefore, the Division recommends the Commission approve this notice.
