Dear Ms. Slawson,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed E Fiber Moab, LLC's ("E Fiber Moab") and E Fiber San Juan, LLC's ("E Fiber San Juan") proposed original new local tariff for service, as referenced above, filed December 7, 2021 (collectively, "Tariff"). The Tariff defines the rates, terms, and conditions of the services to be offered by E Fiber Moab and E Fiber San Juan (jointly, "E Fiber"). E Fiber requests an effective date of January 1, 2022. The PSC also reviewed the comments of the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed on December 20, 2021.

DPU recommends the PSC approve the Tariff, effective January 1, 2022. DPU states that (1) the R1 and B1 rates in the Tariff (as defined therein) are consistent with the affordable base rate set forth in Utah Admin. Code R746-8-401, (2) the Tariff is generally consistent with Utah Administrative Rules, and (3) it has no objections to the Tariff.

Based on the PSC's review of E Fiber's filing and DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC approves E Fiber's proposed Tariff as filed, effective January 1, 2022.
