ISSUED: January 20, 2023

Pursuant to the Notice of Virtual Scheduling Conference issued on December 29, 2022, the Public Service Commission (PSC) held a scheduling conference in this docket on January 18, 2023. Representatives from Qwest Corporation, the Division of Public Utilities, the Office of Consumer Services, the Utah Rural Telecom Association, the PSC, and at least one member of the general public attended. During the scheduling conference, the parties stipulated to the following schedule, which the PSC approves and adopts:

¹ The parties have not yet determined whether they will file potentially dispositive motions but have agreed to schedule this placeholder deadline for purposes of such motions. The parties further agreed that if any potentially dispositive motion is filed, any opposition thereto must be filed 14 days thereafter, and any reply in support of the initial filing must be filed 7 days after the opposition filing. If a potentially dispositive motion is filed, the parties acknowledged the surrebuttal testimony and final hearing dates as currently set forth herein will need to be changed.

DISCOVERY

Discovery turn-around times are 14 calendar days until March 31, 2023; 7 days until April 28, 2023; and best efforts thereafter. Parties shall serve discovery requests and responses by electronic mail. In the event a document produced in response to a discovery request cannot reasonably be transmitted by electronic mail, the party disclosing the document shall provide an electronic copy of the document on CD (or, if an electronic copy is not available, a paper copy).

MOTIONS AND BRIEFING

All non-dispositive motions shall be filed in conformity with R746-1-301 of the Utah Administrative Code. All potentially dispositive motions and briefing shall be filed in conformity with the applicable rule of the Utah Rules of Civil Procedure, except the page limits (excluding attachments or exhibits) shall be 15 for opening briefs, 10 for opposition briefs, and 10 for reply briefs.

² This scheduling conference will occur only if a potentially dispositive motion is filed; if so, this scheduling conference will establish new deadlines for filing surrebuttal testimony and the final hearing and public witness hearing dates.

NOTICE OF HEARING

If a potentially dispositive motion is **not** filed, a hearing in this docket will be conducted on **Thursday, May 18, 2023, at 9:00 a.m., Fourth Floor Hearing Room 403, Heber M.
