Re: *Interconnection Agreement between Navajo Communications Company, Inc. d/b/a Frontier Navajo Communications Company and Teleport Communications America, LLC; Docket No. 22-050-01*

Dear Ms. Zink,

On February 15, 2022, Navajo Communications Company, Inc. d/b/a Frontier Navajo Communications Company (“Navajo”), and Teleport Communications America, LLC (“Teleport”) submitted to the Public Service Commission (PSC) for approval an Agreement for Interconnection, Traffic Exchange, and 911 Services (“Agreement”). The Agreement defines the general terms and conditions by which Navajo and Teleport will interconnect their telecommunications networks, operate, route calls, settle accounts, and undertake other required interactions.

On February 24, 2022, the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed comments recommending the PSC acknowledge receipt of the Agreement. In making its recommendation, DPU comments that the Agreement was negotiated in good faith and without unfair discrimination, and that DPU sees no reason to reject the Agreement.

There being no recommendation opposing the Agreement, the PSC acknowledges that, consistent with 47 U.S.C. § 252(e), the Agreement is deemed approved effective May 16, 2022.
