Dear Ms. Zink,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed the proposed revisions to Navajo Communications Company, Inc. d/b/a Frontier Navajo Communications Company ("Navajo") General Exchange Tariff – Utah ("Tariff"), Sheet No. 2, Section 10, Miscellaneous Service, filed on January 14, 2022. Navajo states that the revisions increase its convenience fee, per occurrence nonrecurring charge ("Fee") from \$4.50 to \$10.00, effective February 20, 2022.

The Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed comments on January 20, 2022 and supplementary comments on February 9, 2022. DPU explains that the Fee is added to a customer's bill if the customer makes a payment through a company representative. After reviewing cost data provided by Navajo, DPU concludes the proposed fee is justified, states it has no objection to the proposed change, and recommends the PSC approve Navajo's proposed revisions to the Tariff, effective February 20, 2022.

Based on the PSC's review of Navajo's filing and DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC finds the proposed fee increase is justified and approves Navajo's proposed revisions to its Tariff as filed, effective February 20, 2022.
