This filing is made in compliance with the Federal Communication Commission's (FCC) Order 20-143; Part 51 – Interconnection; Subpart M – 8YY Transition; §51.909 Transition of rate-of-return carrier access charges; Step 3. The FCC Order further established a three step glidepath reduction to a uniform, nationwide toll free database query rate. Step 3 requires interstate and intrastate originating End Office Access Service rate elements for Toll Free Calls to be reduced by one-half. It also requires the rates for intrastate and interstate Toll Free Database Query Charges to be reduce by one-half to the transitional rate of \$0.0002 per query set forth in paragraph (o)(2) of 47 CFR §51.909. South Central Utah Telephone Association, Inc. proposes a reduction to the required rate level.



This filing also updates the SCUTA's interstate FCC Tariff references from the National Exchange Carrier Association (NECA) FCC Tariff No. 5. Effective July 1, 2022, SCUTA will exit the NECA Traffic Sensitive Pool and FCC Tariff for switched and special access services and will instead tariff those services in the Moss Adams FCC Tariff No. 1. As has been approved in the past for other rate changes, SCUTA proposes to use references to its new interstate FCC Tariff (Moss Adams Tariff No. 1) to effectuate the rate transitions.

Transmitted herewith are PDF documents – one showing the changed pages with revisions indicated via strikeout, and the other showing the changes as they will appear in the proposed new tariff. It is requested that this filing become effective July 1, 2022.

This filing will not increase any rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with other Tariff sections.
