The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed UBTA-UBET Communications Inc.'s ("UBTA-UBET") proposed revisions to its P.S.C.U. No. 1 Tariff ("Tariff"), filed on July 8, 2022 (the "Filing"). UBTA-UBET indicates its proposed Tariff revisions generally update outdated tariff sheets, eliminate unused sheets, update service offerings, and modify and consolidate rates. The updated Tariff also reflects the new issue date, a new effective date, and the docket number. UBTA-UBET also explains that it was easier to modify the entire Tariff due to the scope of changes made and the prior format of the original Tariff. UBTA-UBET requests the updated Tariff become effective August 16, 2022.

The PSC also reviewed the comments of the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed on July 22, 2022. DPU states it has reviewed the submitted tariff sheets and has no objection to the proposed rates and revisions. DPU recommends the PSC approve the filing, effective August 16, 2022.

Based on the PSC's review of UBTA-UBET's Filing, DPU's comments, and its recommendation, the PSC approves UBTA-UBET's proposed revisions to its Tariff, as filed, effective August 16, 2022.
