Dear Ms. Harrell-Simington,

On September 15, 2022, the Public Service Commission of Utah (PSC) received a request for a waiver of Threshold Utilization and/or Months to Exhaust requirements by Electric Lightwave, LLC dba Allstream ("Allstream"). The request is for two blocks of 1,000 sequential numbers in the Utah 385 NPA, within the SALT LAKE CITY Rate Center, which Allstream cannot provide based on its current inventory.

The Utah Division of Public Utilities (DPU) reported to the PSC that Allstream has a verifiable need on the part of one of its customers for additional numbering resources. The DPU recommends the PSC grant the requested waiver. Based on the authority delegated to the states in paragraphs 57-66 of the FCC's Third Report and Order on Numbering Resource Optimization, the PSC grants Allstream's request for a waiver of the Threshold Utilization and/or Months to Exhaust requirements, thereby allowing National Pooling Administrator to provide Allstream with the necessary number blocks in the 385 NPA SALT LAKE CITY Rate Center.
