Spectrotel, Inc. to Spectrotel Ultimate Holdings, LLC.

Recommendation (Acknowledge)

The Division of Public Utilities ("Division") has reviewed the notification of the indirect transfer of control of Spectrotel of the West, LLC ("Spectrotel West") and Spectrotel Ultimate Holdings, LLC ("Spectrotel Holdings") (together the "Applicants"). The public interest will be promoted by the Public Service Commission ("Commission") acknowledging this indirect transfer of control.

The Division expects that, based on history that a filing of this type and with the information submitted by the Applicants, there will be no objections or opposition to this recommendation. Therefore, the Division requests that this docket be adjudicated informally in accordance with R746-110-1.

Discussion

On or about December 16, 2022, Spectrotel West and Spectrotel Holdings notified the Commission of a transaction, which will result in the indirect transfer of control of Spectrotel West to Spectrotel Holdings.

DPU Action Request Response Docket No. 22-2543-01

Spectrotel West is a Delaware limited liability corporation, headquartered at 3535 Route 66, Suite 7, Neptune, New Jersey 07753. It received authorization to provide public

telecommunications services in the State of Utah by the Commission on December 06,

2011, Docket No. 11-2543-01. Spectrotel West is a majority-owned subsidiary of Spectrotel,

Inc.

Spectrotel Holdings is a Delaware limited liability corporation, headquartered at 1900 K

Street NW, Suite 650, Washington, DC 20006. It is managed by Grain Management, LLC,

which invests in and manages communication infrastructure.

On or about October 04, 2022, Spectrotel, Inc. and Spectrotel Holdings entered into an

agreement where Spectrotel Holdings would purchase all the outstanding equity interest in

Spectrotel, Inc., the parent company of Spectrotel West. The agreement will result in the

indirect transfer of control of Spectrotel West to Spectrotel Holdings.

The Applicants submit that the transaction described herein will serve the public interest.

The Applicants further submit that the transaction will be conducted in a manner that will be

largely transparent to its customers. The transaction will not result in a change of carrier for

customers or any assignment of authorizations, and in no event will it result in the

discontinuance, reduction, loss, or impairment of service to customers.

Conclusion

The Division has reviewed the notice filed by the Applicants for the transfer of control and

concludes that the Applicants are in compliance with Commission Rule R746-349-7. The

Division recommends the Commission acknowledge this notice.
