STIPUPLATED SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT, MOTION TO AMEND THE SCHEDULING ORDER AND FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

Pursuant to Utah Code §§ 54-10a-30, 54-7-1 and UTAH ADMIN. CODE r. 746-101, the Office of Consumer Services (OCS) hereby files the Stipulated Settlement Agreement, attached as exhibit 1, and this Motion to Amend the Scheduling Order and for Expedited Treatment. The OCS, the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) and AirVoice Wireless, LLC (AirVoice), collectively (Parties) have entered into a Settlement Stipulation and seek to have the settlement approved by the Public Service Commission of Utah (PSC). The Parties requests that the remaining schedule in this docket be vacated and an amended hearing date on the approval of the settlement be set for July 26, 2022, at 9:00 am.

On March 22, 2022, AirVoice filed a Petition seeking designation as an Eligible

Telecommunication Carriers in the state of Utah for the purpose of receiving federal universal

Lifeline support, federal enhanced tribal universal service Lifeline support and Lifeline support

from the Utah Universal Service Fund. The PSC held a virtual scheduling conference in this

docket on April 5, 2022 and issued a Scheduling Order on April 7, 2022. On May 13, 2022,

AirVoice filed the Testimony of Henry Do in support of its Petition.

Since the filing of Mr. Do's testimony, the Parties have engaged in good faith settlement

negotiations and have reach a settlement agreement concerning the issues raised in AirVoice's

Petition, delineated in the attached Settlement Stipulation. Therefore, the OCS requests that the

remaining schedule be vacated and a hearing on the approval of the settlement stipulation,

pursuant to Utah Code § 54-7-1, be set for July 26, 2022, at 9:00 am.

The OCS has provided a copy of this Motion to the DPU and AirVocie and both parties

have represented they support this Motion. The OCS is unaware of anyone opposing this

Motion. Because the existing Scheduling Order provides for the filing of direct testimony on
