ISSUED: July 12, 2022

On April 7, 2022, the Public Service Commission (PSC) issued a Scheduling Order and Notice of Hearing (“Scheduling Order”) in this docket establishing filing deadlines and an in-person hearing for September 14, 2022. On July 11, 2022, AirVoice Wireless, LLC (“AirVoice”) filed a Motion to Participate Telephonically in Hearing (“AirVoice’s Motion”). AirVoice requests its counsel and witness be allowed to participate in the hearing telephonically. AirVoice states the Office of Consumer Services (OCS) and the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) do not object to AirVoice’s Motion.

Also on July 11, 2022, OCS filed a Motion to Amend the Scheduling Order and for Expedited Treatment (“OCS’s Motion”). OCS, DPU, and AirVoice (collectively, the “Parties”) concurrently filed a Stipulated Settlement Agreement (“Settlement Agreement”). OCS states the Parties seek the PSC’s approval of the Settlement Agreement, request the remaining schedule be vacated, and request an amended hearing date of July 26, 2022. OCS further states it has communicated with DPU and AirVoice and that both parties have represented they support OCS’s Motion. OCS further states it is not aware of any opposition to the Motion.

Good cause appearing, and based on AirVoice’s and OCS’s representation that the Parties support the Motions, AirVoice’s Motion and OCS’s Motion are granted. All remaining filing deadlines are vacated and the schedule is amended as follows:
