Dear Mr. Cox,

On April 18, 2022, Skyline filed its Annual Report for Calendar Year 2021 ("Report") with the Public Service Commission (PSC). On September 1, 2022, the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed its recommendation with the PSC stating that, based on its review of the Report, Skyline does not qualify for Utah Universal Public Telecommunications Support Fund ("UUSF") payments in calendar year 2023.<sup>1</sup> DPU noted that Skyline is not currently receiving distributions from the UUSF and that no adjustments to the UUSF eligibility for Skyline are necessary. On September 2, 2022, the PSC issued a Notice of Filing and Comment Period, seeking comments on DPU's recommendation on or before October 3, 2022. The PSC received no additional comments beyond DPU's amended comments.

Based on the PSC's review of the Report, and on DPU's uncontested recommendation, and there being no comments filed during the comment period, the PSC finds and concludes that Skyline does not qualify for a disbursement from the UUSF in 2023 under Utah Code Ann. § 54-8b-15. The PSC will take no further action in this docket.
