Dear Mr. Asay,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed Union Telephone Company, Inc.'s ("Union") proposed revisions to Page No. 62 of its P.S.C. Utah No. 3 Tariff ("Tariff"), filed on May 30, 2023 (the "Filing"). Union submits the Filing in accordance with Federal Communications Commission (FCC) amended rules that implement 8YY access charge reform.¹ Union indicates its proposed Tariff revisions reduce the relevant rates, as required by the FCC's 8YY access charge reform order ("Order"), and requests an effective date of July 1, 2023.

The PSC also reviewed the comments of the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed on June 13, 2023. DPU states the proposed revisions appear to comply with the FCC's Order and therefore recommends the PSC approve them, effective July 1, 2023.

Based on the PSC's review of Union's Filing, and DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC approves Union's proposed revisions to its Tariff, as filed, effective July 1, 2023.
