## Recommendation (Acknowledge)

The Division of Public Utilities ("Division") recommends that the Public Service Commission ("Commission") acknowledge the requested name change from Metropolitan Telecommunications of Utah, Inc. d/b/a MetTel's to Metropolitan Telecommunications of Utah, LLC d/b/a MetTel ("MetTel").

The Division expects that, based on history that a filing of this type and with the information submitted by the company, there will be no objections or opposition to this recommendation. Therefore, the Division requests that this docket be adjudicated informally in accordance with R746-110-1.

## Discussion

On or about July 10, 2023, Metropolitan Telecommunications of Utah, Inc. d/b/a MetTel, filed a letter with the Commission indicating the company will be changing its name to Metropolitan Telecommunications of Utah, LLC d/b/a MetTel. The name change will not
