Re: **Docket No. 23-2617-01**, In the Matter of the Intrado Communications, LLC's Notice of an Internal Reorganization that will Result in a Pro Forma Change in its Ownership Structure.

Recommendation (Acknowledge)

The Division of Public Utilities ("Division") recommends that the Public Service Commission ("Commission") acknowledge the notification of the internal reorganization and pro forma change of Intrado Communications, LLC ("Intrado").

The Division expects that, based on history that a filing of this type and with the information submitted by the company, there will be no objections or opposition to this recommendation. Therefore, the Division requests that this docket be adjudicated informally in accordance with R746-110-1.

Discussion

On or about January 26, 2023, Intrado filed a notice with the Commission that it will be part of an internal reorganization and pro forma change in its ownership.

Intrado is a Delaware limited liability company, and its principal place of business is located at 3200 W. Pleasant Run Road, Suite 300, Lancaster, Texas 75146. It was issued a

Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“CPCN”) on May 22, 2020, in Docket No. 20-2617-01.

It is the intent of Intrado to complete a minor internal reorganization that will result in a pro forma change in its ownership structure without affecting the company’s ultimate ownership or control. The reorganization that will take place involves Mount Olympus Holdings, Inc being replaced by West-Olympus, LLC. Intrado states that no other changes to Intrado ownership structure are anticipated.

Intrado states that the internal reorganization will serve the public interest. Following the reorganization, the company will continue to be ultimately owned and controlled by the same parties that own and control the company today. It further states that this internal reorganization will be imperceptible to the customers and vendors of Intrado and will not result in any discontinuance, reduction, loss, or impairment of service to any customer.

Conclusion

The Division recommends that the Commission acknowledge this notification for the restructuring and pro forma changes by Intrado and make any necessary changes and amendments to all the required documents.
