ISSUED: November 21, 2023

On November 3, 2023, Intrado Communications, LLC ("Intrado") notified the Public Service Commission (PSC) of its name change (the "Notice") to Hypercube Networks, LLC ("Hypercube"). Intrado holds a certificate of public convenience and necessity ("CPCN") to provide "competitive local exchange and resold interexchange services in Utah," granted pursuant to the PSC's May 22, 2020, order in Docket No. 20-2617-01. Hypercube represents that the corporate name change "will have no effect on the rates, terms, or conditions of service offered to customers."¹

On November 13, 2023, the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed a memorandum recommending the PSC acknowledge the name change, make necessary changes to all relevant documents, and adjudicate the docket informally in accordance with Utah Admin. Code R746-110-1. DPU confirms the name change will not impact any customers in Utah, nor result in any changes to the services that Intrado currently offers to its Utah customers.

ORDER

The Notice shows Intrado updated its new name to Hybercube with the Utah Division of Corporations and Commercial Code. DPU's memorandum confirms no customers in Utah will be adversely affected. Based on the PSC's review of the Notice, Intrado's representations, and DPU's recommendation, the PSC acknowledges Intrado's name change to "Hypercube Networks, LLC" and amends its CPCN to reflect its new business name. The amended CPCN is attached as Exhibit A.

Notice of Opportunity for Agency Review or Rehearing

Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-301 and 54-7-15, a party may seek agency review or rehearing of this written order by filing a request for review or rehearing with the PSC within 30 days after the issuance of the order. Responses to a request for agency review or rehearing must be filed within 15 days of the filing of the request for review or rehearing. If the PSC fails to grant a request for review or rehearing within 30 days after the filing of a request for review or rehearing, it is deemed denied. Judicial review of the PSC's final agency action may be obtained by filing a Petition for Review with the Utah Supreme Court within 30 days after final agency action. Any Petition for Review must comply with the requirements of Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-401, 63G-4-403, and the Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure.
