BACKGROUND

On May 3, 2023, ExteNet Telecom Solutions, Inc. ("ExteNet"), formerly known as Hudson Fiber Network Inc. ("Hudson"), notified the Public Service Commission (PSC) of its name change to ExteNet Telecom Solutions, Inc. ("Notification"). If the PSC fails to grant a request for review or rehearing within 30 days after the filing of a request for review or rehearing, it is deemed denied. Judicial review of the PSC's final agency action may be obtained by filing a Petition for Review with the Utah Supreme Court within 30 days after final agency action. Any Petition for Review must comply with the requirements of Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-401, 63G-4-403, and the Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure.
