MOTION TO DEVIATE

Applicant is filing concurrently with this Motion an Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Provide Facilities-Based Public Telecommunications Services within the State of Utah ("Application"). While counsel's law firm recently had approval to file documents through the State of Utah's secure file transfer protocol server, that approval has since lapsed. Counsel has been informed that obtaining a new approval could take up to two weeks. Applicant therefore requests permission to file a paper copy of **confidential Exhibit E** accompanying the Application.

Pursuant to Utah Admin. Code R746-1-109(2), Applicant attests that because filing and service through the SFTP server is not currently possible in this case and would cause unnecessary delay, the rule imposes a hardship that outweighs the benefit(s) of the rule.

Wherefore, Applicant requests that the Commission permit Applicant to deviate from the electronic filing requirements as described above.
