Dear Mr. Denzel,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed Central Utah Telephone, Inc.'s ("Central Utah") proposed revisions to Page Nos. 2 and 48 of its PSC Utah No. 2 Tariff ("Tariff"), filed on May 16, 2024 (the "Filing"). Central Utah submits the Filing in accordance with Federal Communications Commission (FCC) interstate carrier compensation rules. Central Utah indicates its proposed Tariff revisions adjust the relevant rates, as required by the April 8, 2024 rate increase announced by the National Exchange Carrier Association ("NECA Order")¹ and requests an effective date of July 1, 2024.

The PSC also reviewed the comments of the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed on May 30, 2024. DPU states the proposed revisions appear to comply with the NECA Order and therefore recommends the PSC approve them, effective July 1, 2024.

Based on the PSC's review of Central Utah's Filing and DPU's comments, and the PSC's understanding of DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC approves Central Utah's proposed revisions to its Tariff, as filed, effective July 1, 2024.
