Recommendation (Approval)

The Division of Public Utilities (DPU or Division) has reviewed the tariff filing and recommends the Public Service Commission (Commission) approve Navajo Communications Company, Inc. d/b/a Frontier Navajo Communications Company's (Navajo) request to grandfather residential bundles effective on January 1, 2025.

Discussion

On November 25, 2024, Navajo submitted revised tariff sheets for the residential bundles. The Division reviewed the redlined version and the corresponding updated sheets and found that the changes are mainly to the Heading or Footer Notes only. There are no changes to the tariff amounts Navajo will be charging.
