Re: Docket No. 24-050-T01 - *Navajo Communications Company, Inc. d/b/a Frontier Navajo Communications Company's Tariff Revisions to Grandfather Residential Bundles*

Dear Ms. Zink,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Navajo Communications Company, Inc. d/b/a Frontier Navajo Communications Company's ("Navajo") tariff revisions to grandfather residential bundles ("Tariff"), filed on November 25, 2024 (the "Filing"), in accordance with Utah Admin. Code R746-405-2(D)(6). Navajo indicates that the purpose of the Filing is to grandfather residential bundles. Navajo also states the Filing does not constitute a violation of state law or PSC rule as set forth in Utah Admin. Code R746-405-2(D)(3)(g). Navajo requests an effective date of January 1, 2025.

The PSC also reviewed the comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) on December 6, 2024. DPU found no changes to the Tariff amounts charged by Navajo, with changes mainly to the headings or footers. DPU believes the Tariff is consistent with Utah Administrative Rule(s) and recommends the PSC approve the Tariff, effective January 1, 2025.

Based on the PSC's review of the Filing, and DPU's comments and recommendations, the PSC approves Navajo's proposed revisions to its Tariff, as filed, effective January 1, 2025.
