The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed UBTA-UBET Communications, Inc.'s ("UBTA-UBET") proposed revisions to Sheet No. 20 of its P.S.C. Utah No. 1 Tariff ("Tariff"), filed on May 30, 2024 (the "Filing"). UBTA-UBET submits the Filing in accordance with the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) increase in Access Recovery Charge (ARC). UBTA-UBET indicates its proposed Tariff revisions will not result in any rate changes to the customer and requests an effective date of July 1, 2024.<sup>1</sup>

The PSC also reviewed the comments of the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed on June 6, 2024. DPU states UBTA-UBET's ARC rate is currently \$5.00. DPU represents the proposed revisions increase the ARC rate by \$1.00, and reduce the state rate by \$1.00. DPU concludes the offsetting rate changes will not impact the customers and recommends the PSC approve the revisions, effective July 1, 2024.

Based on the PSC's review of UBTA-UBET's Filing, and DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC approves UBTA-UBET's proposed revisions to its Tariff, as filed, effective July 1, 2024.
