ORDER ACKNOWLEDGING
RESTRUCTURING
AND AMENDING CERTIFICATE OF
PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY

ISSUED: February 20, 2024

BACKGROUND

On January 30, 2024, AT&T Corp. and AT&T Enterprises, Inc. ("Company")¹ notified ("Notification") the Public Service Commission (PSC) of an impending internal restructuring ("Restructuring"). Specifically, AT&T Corp. will: (1) merge with AT&T Enterprises, Inc.; (2) AT&T Enterprises, Inc. will be converted to AT&T Enterprises, LLC; and (3) AT&T Corp. will cease to exist. As a result of the Restructuring, AT&T Enterprises, LLC will assume the assets of AT&T Corp. and the Company therefore requests the PSC issue an updated certificate to reflect the Restructuring. Currently, AT&T Corp. holds a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") as a competitive local exchange carrier to provide public telecommunications services in Utah, granted pursuant to the PSC's October 16, 2012, order in Docket No. 12-087-01.

On February 6, 2024, the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed comments recommending the PSC acknowledge the Notification. DPU represents that the Restructuring will result in a single entity wholly owned by AT&T Inc. named AT&T Enterprises, LLC. DPU represents that the purpose of the Restructuring is to convert

AT&T Inc. subsidiaries to limited liability companies. Additionally, DPU states AT&T Enterprises, LLC will continue to provide services to existing customers at the same terms, conditions, and rates without reduction, loss, impairment, or discontinuance of service. Further, DPU requests this docket be adjudicated informally in accordance with Utah Admin. Code R746-110-1, based on the history of this type of filing and the information submitted by the Company.

ORDER

Based on the Notification, DPU's recommendation and there being no opposition, the PSC concludes that, pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 54-8b-3.4, the Company is exempt from Utah Code Ann. § 54-4-28, and accepts DPU's request to adjudicate the docket informally under Utah Admin. Code R746-110-1. Accordingly, the PSC acknowledges the Restructuring as described in the Notification and amends the CPCN to reflect the new business name, AT&T Enterprises, LLC. The amended CPCN is attached as Exhibit A and is only effective as of the completion of the Restructuring and the PSC's receipt of an updated certificate of registration issued by the Utah Division of Corporations and Commercial Code.

Notice of Opportunity for Agency Review or Rehearing

Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-301 and 54-7-15, a party may seek agency review or rehearing of this written order by filing a request for review or rehearing with the PSC within 30 days after the issuance of the order. Responses to a request for agency review or rehearing must be filed within 15 days of the filing of the request for review or rehearing. If the PSC fails to grant a request for review or rehearing within 30 days after the filing of a request for review or rehearing, it is deemed denied. Judicial review of the PSC's final agency action may be obtained by filing a Petition for Review with the Utah Supreme Court within 30 days after final agency action. Any Petition for Review must comply with the requirements of Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-401, 63G-4-403, and the Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure.
