Dear Mr. Cox,

On April 17, 2024, Skyline filed its Annual Report for Calendar Year 2023 ("Report") with the Public Service Commission (PSC). On September 10, 2024, the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed its recommendation with the PSC stating that, based on its review of the Report, Skyline does not qualify for Utah Universal Public Telecommunications Support Fund ("UUSF") payments in calendar year 2025.¹ DPU noted that Skyline is not currently receiving distributions from the UUSF and no adjustments to its UUSF eligibility are necessary. On September 4, 2024, the PSC issued a Notice of Filing and Comment Period, seeking comments on DPU's recommendation on or before October 4, 2024. Additionally, the PSC indicated that it would accept challenges to DPU's final recommendations by November 15, 2024. The PSC received no comments or challenges to DPU's final recommendation by the November 15, 2024 deadline under Utah Admin. Code R746-8-401(10)(f).

Based on the PSC's review of the Report, DPU's uncontested recommendation, and there being no comments or reply comments filed during the comment period, the PSC finds and concludes that Skyline does not qualify for a disbursement from the UUSF in 2025 under Utah Code Ann. § 54-8b-15. The PSC will take no further action in this Docket.

¹ DPU filed original comments on September 3, 2024 and revised comments on September 10, 2024, stating Skyline did not qualify for UUSF in 2024 or 2025.
