Dear Mr. Cox,

On April 14 and April 15, 2025, Central Utah Telephone, Inc. d/b/a CentraCom (“Central Utah”) filed its Annual Report and Report of Gross Revenue for Calendar Year 2024 (“Report”) with the Public Service Commission (PSC). On September 3, 2025, the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed its recommendation to reduce the annual Utah Universal Public Telecommunications Service Support Fund (UUSF) payable to Central Utah to \$0. This is a total elimination of the \$266,962 Central Utah received in 2025. DPU’s recommendation is based on a review of the Report and consideration of several factors, including the adoption of a 9.75% FCC-prescribed Rate of Return. On September 5, 2025, the PSC issued a Notice of Filing and Comment Period, seeking comments on DPU’s recommendation on or before October 6, 2025. Additionally, in its November 4, 2025 Notice of Comment Period, the PSC indicated that it would accept challenges to DPU’s final recommendations<sup>1</sup> by November 17, 2025. The PSC received no comments or challenges to DPU’s final recommendation by the November 17, 2025, deadline under Utah Admin. Code R746-8-401(10)(f).

The PSC will take no further action in this Docket.
