Dear Ms. Matushek,

On April 15 and April 23, 2025, Citizens Telecommunications Company of Utah d/b/a Frontier Communications of Utah ("Citizens") filed its Report of Gross Revenue and Annual Report for Calendar Year 2024 ("Report") with the Public Service Commission (PSC). On September 2, 2025, the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed its recommendation to reduce the annual Utah Universal Public Telecommunications Service Support Fund (UUSF) payable to Citizens to \$0. This is a total elimination of the \$3,022,487 Citizens received in 2025. DPU stated that the reduction was due to Citizens' increased network access revenue in 2024 and decreased operating costs. On September 5, 2025, the PSC issued a Notice of Filing and Comment Period, seeking comments on DPU's recommendation on or before October 6, 2025. Additionally, in its November 4, 2025 Notice of Comment Period, the PSC indicated that it would accept challenges to DPU's final recommendations¹ by November 17, 2025. The PSC received no comments or challenges to DPU's final recommendation by the November 17, 2025 deadline under Utah Admin. Code R746-8-401(10)(f).

Based on the PSC's review of the Report, DPU's uncontested recommendation, and there being no comments or reply comments filed during the comment period, the PSC finds and concludes that Citizens does not qualify for a disbursement from the UUSF in 2026 under Utah Code Ann. § 54-8b-15. The PSC will take no further action in this Docket.
