Dear Ms. Zink,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Citizens Telecommunications Company of Utah d/b/a Frontier Communications of Utah's ("Citizens") Tariff Revisions to the Vacation Get Away Service ("Tariff"), filed on April 16, 2025 (the "Filing"), in accordance with Utah Admin. Code R746-405-2(D)(6). Citizens indicates that the purpose of the Filing is to change Vacation Get Away Service from a non-recurring charge to a monthly recurring charge. Citizens also states the Filing does not constitute a violation of state law or PSC rule as set forth in Utah Admin. Code R746-405-2(D)(3)(g). Citizens requests an effective date of May 16, 2025.

The PSC also reviewed the comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) on April 23, 2025. DPU confirmed the effective implementation of all necessary adjustments within the notes and the accurate reflection of tariff amount changes. DPU concludes that Citizens' revised Tariff is consistent with Utah Administrative Rule(s) and recommends the PSC approve the Tariff, effective May 16, 2025.

Based on the PSC's review of the Filing, DPU's comments and recommendations, the PSC approves Citizens' proposed revisions to its Tariff, as filed, effective May 16, 2025.
