Dear Ms. Spears,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Gunnison Telephone Company's ("Gunnison") proposed Tariff Revisions to its interstate switched access rates (the "Tariff Revisions") filed on May 20, 2025 (the "Filing"), in compliance with specific FCC orders from November 2011 and April 2012, which mandate that all switched access rates must be equal to or lower than the National Exchange Carrier Association's (NECA) interstate switched access rates. Gunnison requests an effective date of July 1, 2025.

The PSC also reviewed the comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) on June 3, 2025. DPU has reviewed the proposed Tariff Revisions and confirmed their alignment with the NECA database. DPU indicates that the financial impact of these changes is considered immaterial, with a forecasted revenue loss of under \$900.00, as Gunnison only uses 5 out of 35 of the affected rates. DPU has no concerns with the proposed Tariff Revisions and recommends the PSC approve the Filing, effective July 1, 2025.

Based on the PSC's review of the proposed Tariff Revisions, DPU's comments and recommendations, the PSC approves the Filing, as submitted, effective July 1, 2025.
