Dear Ms. Wagner,

On August 7, 2025, Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC ("CenturyLink") filed with the Public Service Commission (PSC) the Cageless Collocation Bay Procurement Amendments (the "Amendments") to the Interconnection Agreement (the "Agreement") between CenturyLink and Bandwidth.com CLEC, LLC (the "Filing"). The proposed Amendments add terms, conditions, and rates for Cageless Collocation Bay Procurement.

On August 12, 2025, the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed comments recommending the PSC acknowledge receipt of the proposed Agreement. DPU states that the Agreement was voluntarily negotiated in good faith and without unfair discrimination, and it sees no reason to reject it.

Based on DPU's comments and recommendations and in the absence of any opposition to the Filing, the PSC acknowledges the Filing. The Agreement and Amendments are deemed approved by operation of federal law under 47 U.S.C. § 252(e), effective 90 days from the date of filing.
