Dear Ms. Wagner,

On December 18, 2025, Qwest Corporation dba CenturyLink QC filed with the Public Service Commission (PSC) a Single Point of Presence in the LATA Amendment to its Interconnection Agreement with Union Telephone Company (the "Filing"). The Filing amends the existing Interconnection Agreement (collectively, the "Agreement") by incorporating new terms and conditions.

On January 8, 2026, the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed comments recommending the PSC acknowledge the receipt of the proposed Agreement. DPU states that the Agreement was voluntarily negotiated in good faith and without unfair discrimination, and it sees no reason to reject it.

Based on DPU's comments and recommendations and in the absence of any opposition to the Filing, the PSC acknowledges the Filing. The Agreement is deemed approved by operation of federal law under 47 U.S.C. § 252(e), effective 90 days from the date of filing.
