Navajo Communications Company's Tariff Revisions to the Vacation Get Away

Service

Recommendation (Approve Tariff Sheets)

The Division of Public Utilities ("Division") has reviewed Navajo Telecommunications Company of Utah d/b/a Frontier Communications Company's ("Navajo / Frontier"") tariff revision filed on April 16, 2025. The Division recommends the Public Service Commission ("Commission") approve the tariff revisions to the residential bundles as filed. The Division also recommends the tariff changes become effective on May 16, 2025, as requested.

Discussion

Around April 16, 2025, Navajo/Frontier submitted revised tariff sheets for its residential bundles, aiming to modify the Vacation Get Away Service from a \$39.00 non-recurring charge to a \$5.00 monthly recurring charge. After a thorough review of the tariff sheets, the Division confirmed that all necessary adjustments were effectively implemented in the heading or footer notes and the changes to the tariff amount were accurately reflected.



Conclusion

Based on its review, the Division concludes that the revised tariff is consistent with Utah Administrative Rule(s) and recommends that the Commission approve the tariff effective May 16, 2025.
