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Re: Docket No. 25-2292-01 - *QuantumShift Communications, Inc. d/b/a vCom Solutions, Inc.'s Notice of Transfer of Indirect Control to AppSmart TGN, Inc.*

All,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed the notice ("Notice") filed on February 7, 2025, regarding the Proposed Transfer of Indirect Control ("Transaction") of QuantumShift Communications, Inc. ("QuantumShift") to AppSmart TGN, Inc. ("AppSmart"). vCom Solutions, Inc. ("vCom") is a California corporation and the direct parent entity of QuantumShift. AppSmart will indirectly acquire ownership and control of QuantumShift by acquiring one hundred percent (100%) of the issued and outstanding shares of vCom.

The Notice claims that the Transaction is in the public interest because QuantumShift will gain access to AppSmart's financial resources and continue to possess the financial, managerial, and technical qualifications to provide telecommunications services in Utah. The Notice states no PSC approval of the Transaction is required.

The PSC also reviewed the comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) on February 14, 2025. DPU summarizes the Notice and concludes that the Notice complies with Utah Admin. Code R746-349-7 and that reasonable

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documentation has been provided. DPU states that the public interest will be promoted by the PSC acknowledging the Notice and as a result of the transaction, the companies should be in a better position to provide expanded and advanced telecommunications services in the State of Utah. DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge the Notice. DPU does not address whether the Transaction requires PSC approval.

No party has identified a statutory or other legal requirement for the PSC to approve the proposed Transaction, and no party has requested a declaratory ruling on the issue pursuant to Utah Admin. Code R746-101-1, *et seq.* Accordingly, the PSC acknowledges the Notice was filed and gives notice it will take no further action in this docket unless a party files a request for agency action and explains the basis on which the PSC may or should act.
