Dear Mr. Rutkowski,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Direct Communications Cedar Valley, LLC's ("Direct Communications") proposed Tariff Revisions to its interstate switched access rates (the "Tariff Revisions") filed on May 28, 2025 (the "Filing"), in compliance with Federal Communications Commission (FCC) rules, which mandate an 18.4483% decrease on all interstate switched access rates not on a transition. Direct Communications requests an effective date of July 1, 2025.

The PSC also reviewed the comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) on June 9, 2025. DPU has reviewed the proposed Tariff Revisions and confirmed that the adjustments align with the announced rate decrease. DPU has no concerns with the proposed Tariff Revisions and recommends the PSC approve the Filing, effective July 1, 2025.

Based on the PSC's review of the proposed Tariff Revisions, DPU's comments and recommendations, the PSC approves the Filing, as submitted, effective July 1, 2025.
