Request of CBTS Technology Solutions LLC for Cancellation of its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity	<u>DOCKET NO. 25-2548-01</u>
	<u>ORDER</u>

ISSUED: February 5, 2026

On December 18, 2025, CBTS Technology Solutions LLC (“CBTS”) filed a request with the Public Service Commission (PSC) for cancellation of its certificate of public convenience and necessity (“CPCN”) to provide interexchange services and competitive local exchange services in Utah (the “Request”). On December 19, 2025, the PSC requested the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) to review the Request and provide recommendations regarding the same. DPU filed its comments on January 14, 2026.

DPU recommends that the PSC grant the Request. DPU’s recommendation is based on: (1) its independent research; and (2) CBTS’s representations that it no longer provides regulated telecommunications services in Utah, and therefore the cancellation of its services will not harm the public interest. DPU concludes that CBTS has complied with Utah Admin. Code R746-350.

Based on the PSC’s review of the Request and DPU’s comments and recommendation, and since no opposition was filed, the PSC finds cancellation of CBTS’s CPCN is in the public interest and approves the Request. Accordingly, CBTS’s CPCN, issued on February 27, 2012, in Docket No. 11-2548-01, is canceled, effective on the date of this order.

Notice of Opportunity for Agency Review or Rehearing

Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-301 and 54-7-15, a party may seek agency review or rehearing of this written order by filing a request for review or rehearing with the PSC within 30 days after the issuance of the order. Responses to a request for agency review or rehearing must be filed within 15 days of the filing of the request for review or rehearing. If the PSC fails to grant a request for review or rehearing within 30 days after the filing of a request for review or rehearing, it is deemed denied. Judicial review of the PSC's final agency action may be obtained by filing a Petition for Review with the Utah Supreme Court within 30 days after final agency action. Any Petition for Review must comply with the requirements of Utah Code Ann. §§ 63G-4-401, 63G-4-403, and the Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure.
