Dear Mr. Dean,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed TerraCom Inc. d/b/a Maxsip Tel's ("TerraCom") Notification of Name Change to TerraCom Inc. ("Notice") filed on September 30, 2025. TerraCom states that it will no longer market under the trade name Maxsip Tel and no customers will be affected by this name change. TerraCom was designated as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (ETC) in Utah on November 27, 2023, in Docket No. 23-2642-01.

The Division of Public Utilities (DPU) filed comments on October 2, 2025. DPU comments that the name change will not impact any customers in the state of Utah and will not change the services provided by TerraCom. DPU recommends that the PSC acknowledge the Notice and make the necessary changes to all the required documents.

Based on the PSC's review of the Notice and DPU's comments and recommendations, the PSC acknowledges TerraCom's name change and amends TerraCom's ETC designation to reflect its new business name.
