## Recommendation (Approval)

On or about January 30, 2025, The Division of Public Utilities (“Division”) submitted a recommendation to the Utah Public Service Commission (“Commission”) for approval of the application of eNetworks, LLC (“eNetworks” or “Applicant”) for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“CPCN”).

It has been brought to the attention of the Division that an error was made in the statement that the Applicant is “not currently authorized to provide competitive telecommunication service in any state”. It should have been noted that eNetworks is authorized to provide intrastate telecommunications services in the following states: Alabama, Arkansas, California, Florida, Georgia, Hawaii, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maryland, Minnesota, Missouri, Mississippi, Nevada, North Carolina, New Jersey, Ohio, Oklahoma, Oregon, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, Virginia, Washington, Wisconsin and



West Virginia and it currently has an application for a CPCN before the Arizona Commission.

## **Conclusion**

Based on the Division's review of the application and correction to the action request response submitted on January 30, 2025, the Division concludes that the public interest will be promoted by the Commission granting eNetworks, LLC a CPCN and recommends the Commission approve the application.
