Fiber AssetCo LLC (“Applicant”), through its undersigned counsel, hereby moves the Public Service Commission of Utah for permission to deviate from the electronic filing requirement set forth in Utah Admin. Code R746-1-203. In support of this Motion, Applicant states as follows:

Applicant is filing concurrently with this Motion an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Provide Facilities-Based and Resold Public Telecommunications Services within the State of Utah (“Application”). While counsel’s law firm has attempted to gain approval to file documents through the State of Utah’s secure file transfer protocol server, that approval has not been obtained as of the date of filing of the Application. Applicant therefore requests permission to file a paper copy of **Confidential Exhibit F** accompanying the Application.

Pursuant to Utah Admin. Code R746-1-109(2), Applicant attests that because filing and service through the SFTP server is not currently possible in this case and would cause unnecessary delay, the rule imposes a hardship that outweighs the benefit(s) of the rule.

Wherefore, Applicant requests that the Commission permit Applicant to deviate from the electronic filing requirements as described above.
