## Action Request Response

**Re:** **Docket No. 25-2656-01:** In the Matter of the AMENDED Application of Zayo Network Services, LLC. for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Provide Resold Public Telecommunications Services within the State of Utah.

## Recommendation (Approval)

The Division of Public Utilities (“Division”) has reviewed the request to amend Zayo Network Services, LLC. (“Zayo Network” or “Applicant”) Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“CPCN”) that was initially issued on November 03, 2025, and has found that it has provided the necessary information to fulfill the requirements as stated in the existing Public Service Commission (“Commission”) rules. The public interest will be promoted by the Commission amending Zayo Network’s CPCN and granting it authority to provide switched telecommunication services as requested under the same terms and conditions allowed in other CPCNs.

The Division also recommends that the \$100,000 bond be waived on the basis that the Applicant will not require customer deposits or prepayments of any kind.



Zayo Network has asked that its application be adjudicated informally under Utah Code Ann. § 54-8b-3(1)(b).

The Division expects that based on history, a filing of this type and with the information submitted by Zayo Networks will generate no objections or opposition to this recommendation. Therefore, the Division requests that this docket be adjudicated informally in accordance with Utah Administrative Code R746-110-1.

## **Discussion**

On or about March 05, 2026, Zayo Network filed an application to amend its CPCN. The Division reviewed the application and found the following:

Zayo Network is registered as a foreign corporation within the State of Utah; with its corporate headquarters located at 1401 Wynkoop Street, Suite 500, Denver, CO. 80202.

The Applicant originally applied for and received its CPCN in the State of Utah on November 03, 2025, in Docket No. 25-2656-01. Under this application the Zayo Network requested that it be granted a CPCN under the same terms and conditions allowed in other CPCNs, with the exception of providing switched voice telecommunication services.

In its amended application, Zayo Network has stated that it intends to provide service to wholesale and enterprise customers and will primarily provide point-to-point telecommunications services such as private line and similar services. It plans to offer facilities-based and resold switched voice local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services. The Applicant states that it intends to provide services primarily using its own switches and fiber-based facilities but may also lease facilities from other providers and therefore requests authority to provide both facilities-based and resold services.

Zayo Network expects to provide access to ordinary intraLATA and interLATA message toll calling, operator services, directory assistance, directory listings, and emergency services through interconnection with its underlying carrier.

The Applicant asserts that approval of its amended application will serve the public interest creating and enhancing competition and expanding customer service options. Additionally, the approval of this application will expand the availability of innovative, high quality, reliable and competitively priced telecommunications services in the State of Utah.

## **Conclusion**

Based on the Division's review of the filing, we conclude the public interest will be promoted by the Commission amending Zayo Network Services, LLC. CPCN to include providing switched telecommunications services.
