

RESPONSE TO PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION OF UTAH QUESTIONS

1.1 Regarding the Company's initial application to become an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (ETC) in Utah, the application cited Utah Administrative Code R746-360-1. During the scheduling conference, it was noted that this rule has been repealed. Mr. Patrick Hardy stated the Company would address this matter in direct testimony, but LTE Wireless Inc. did not address this in its filed testimony. Please explain the Company's understanding of the Public Service Commission of Utah administrative rules that apply to its application?

LTE Wireless is now aware that R746-360-1 has been repealed. LTE Wireless has also hired Peter Orr who has extensive experience in lifeline regulation and lifeline operations.

1.2 On page 5 of the Company's application, under the heading "LTE'S LIFELINE PLANS," it states that customers will receive:

- An "unlimited lifeline plan with 5 GB of data for non-tribal customers."
- An "unlimited lifeline plan with 20 GB of data for customers that qualify for Enhanced Tribal Benefit free of charge."

However, on page 5 of Mr. Hassad's direct testimony, it states that:

- "the plan that would be free to the customer provides unlimited talk and text with 4.5 GB of data."

Furthermore, there is no mention of tribal plans or usage in his testimony. Please explain these discrepancies.

LTE Wireless will provide unlimited talk / Text and 4.5 GB of data to Tribal and non Tribal customers.

LTE Wireless proposes to offer one plan at this time. We propose to offer a company discount of our Monthly \$30 plan equal to the difference between monthly federal Lifeline fund support of \$9.25, + \$3.50 from The state of Utah ensuring the Discounted Rate of the Lifeline plan to stay at \$0.00 for subscribers.

Furthermore, LTE Wireless's rate plans that are subject to an activation fee, would be waived for Lifeline participants. LTE Wireless will seek the activation reimbursement where applicable.

1.3 Has the applicant been subject to an enforcement action by the FCC or by any state in which it operates? If so, please explain.

LTE Wireless has not been subject to any enforcement action by the FCC or by any state.

1.4 Has the applicant been assessed any fines, late payment penalties, or any other fees for failing to meet its legal obligations in any state in which it is authorized to do business? If so, please provide a copy of the order or documentation assessing this fine, penalty, or fee.

1.5 Please confirm that LTE Wireless Inc. will use its network, at least in part, to provide Lifeline-supported services

LTE Wireless will use its facilities to provide lifeline supported services.
