Dear Mr. Denzel,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Skyline Telecom d/b/a CentraCom's ("Skyline") proposed Tariff Revisions to its interstate switched access rates (the "Tariff Revisions") filed on May 20, 2025 (the "Filing"), in compliance with Federal Communications Commission (FCC) rules governing intercarrier compensation. Skyline indicates that the proposed rates are based on an 18.4483% interstate switched access rate decrease, as announced by the National Exchange Carrier Association (NECA) on April 10, 2025. Skyline states that if the FCC-approved NECA rates differ, their rates will be adjusted accordingly. Skyline requests an effective date of July 1, 2025.

The PSC also reviewed the comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) on June 3, 2025. DPU comments that Skyline is requesting a decrease in twelve Local Transport rates. DPU's review shows that Skyline uses only one of the twelve available rates: the Local Transport Voice Grade Four Wire rate. The proposed decrease to this specific rate will result in a revenue impact of under \$5,500.00, which the DPU considers to be immaterial. DPU has no concerns with the proposed Tariff Revisions and recommends the PSC approve the Filing, effective July 1, 2025.
