Customer Notice:

Effective on or after July 1, 2026, the Facility Relocation Cost Recovery Fee will be \$1.46 per line per month. This fee helps recover costs incurred when public infrastructure projects such as road construction, land development, or highway widening require relocation of network infrastructure. Charges will apply unless service is canceled before July 1, 2026. Continued use of service constitutes acceptance of this change.

2. GENERAL REGULATIONS - CONDITIONS OF OFFERING

2.6 SPECIAL TAXES, FEES, CHARGES

1. Insofar as practicable, any sales, use, privilege, excise, franchise or occupation tax, costs of furnishing service without charge or similar taxes or impositions now or hereafter levied by the Federal, State, or Local government or any political subdivision or taxing authority thereof may be billed by the Company to its exchange customers on a pro rata basis in the areas wherein such taxes, impositions or other charges shall be levied against the Company.
2. Rate schedules of the Company in Utah do not include any portion of any sales, excise, franchise, or occupation tax, costs of furnishing service without charge, or similar taxes or impositions presently or that may hereafter be levied by the Federal Government, the State of Utah, or any political subdivision or taxing authority thereof.

3. Universal Service Fund Surcharge

Universal Service Fund is established to maintain the universal availability of local exchange service at reasonable rates and to promote the availability of long distance services at reasonably comparable rates throughout the state. Universal Service Fund surcharges are assessed to customers according to Public Service Commission rules.

4. Facility Relocation Cost Recovery Fee

This surcharge is for the recovery of the costs for the relocation of network facilities or infrastructure changes mandated by City, County, State, or Federal authorities, or any other governmental entity of any kind. This incremental charge is billed monthly per retail access line and will be identified on the bill as a Facility Relocation Cost Recovery Fee.
