Dear Mr. Curryer,

The Public Service Commission ("PSC") has reviewed South Central Utah Telephone Association, Inc.'s ("SCUTA") proposed tariff reference revisions dated May 29, 2026, (the "Tariff Revisions"). SCUTA uses tariff references to effectuate mirroring of its intrastate switched access rates to its interstate rate counterpart. These Tariff Revisions update the interstate tariff reference from "Moss Adams LLP FCC Tariff No. 1" to the "Baker Tilly Advisory Group, LP FCC Tariff No. 1" and tariff section references. SCUTA requests an effective date of July 1, 2026.

The PSC also reviewed the comments filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) on June 5, 2026. DPU states it has reviewed the proposed Tariff Revisions submitted by SCUTA to mirror its intrastate switched access rates to their interstate counterpart. DPU finds that updating the interstate tariff reference from "Moss Adams LLP" to "Baker Tilly Advisory Group, LP" ensures mirroring references remain accurate and does not change any of SCUTA's intrastate rates or charges. DPU has no objections to the proposed revisions and recommends the PSC approve the Tariff Revisions as submitted, effective July 1, 2026.

Based on the PSC's review of the proposed Tariff Revisions and DPU's comments and recommendations, the PSC approves the Tariff Revisions as filed, effective July 1, 2026.
