Dear Ms. Wall,

On April 14, 2026, Union Telephone Company, Inc. ("Union Telephone") filed a request with the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) requesting a 30-day extension to file its 2025 Gross Revenue Report ("Request"). The Request should have been filed with the Public Service Commission (PSC), but it was not. The deadline for Union Telephone to file what it refers to as its "Gross Revenue Report," but what is referred to in the Utah Rules of Administrative Procedure as an "annual report," was April 15, 2026.

Subsequently, on April 28, 2026, DPU forwarded the Request to the PSC. The Request represents the reason for the extension is because Union Telephone does not yet have its 2025 audited financial statements.

DPU filed comments on April 30, 2026. DPU recommends approving the Request until May 15, 2026, stating that Union Telephone is current and in good standing with all applicable statutes, administrative rules, and PSC orders regarding the filing of its "2025 Annual ILEC" report.

Based on the PSC's review of the Request and DPU's comments and recommendations, the PSC determines that the requested 30-day extension is reasonable. Given the modest length of the requested extension, we do not see a need to solicit comments. Therefore, a 30-day extension is granted and Union Telephone shall have until and including May 15, 2026, to file its 2025 annual report.
