Re: **Docket No(s). 26-2543-01 and 26-2560-01:** Notice of a Change of Control of Spectrotel of the West, LLC and AireSpring, Inc.

Recommendation (Acknowledge)

The Division of Public Utilities ("Division") has reviewed the notification of the change of control of Spectrotel of the West, LLC ("Spectrotel") and AireSpring, Inc. ("AireSpring") to Spectrotel Ultimate Holdings, LLC ("Spectrotel Ultimate") which is controlled by Spectrum Aggregator, LP ("Spectrum Aggregator") (together the "Applicants"). The public interest will be promoted by the Public Service Commission ("Commission") acknowledging this Change of Control. As a result of the transfer, the companies should be in a better position to provide expanded and advanced telecommunications services in the State of Utah.

Discussion

On May 22, 2026, Spectrotel and AireSpring filed notice of a transaction, under Utah Admin. Code R746-349-7 or Utah Code § 54-8b-3.4 with Commission, which will result in a change of control of Spectrotel and AireSpring to Spectrotel Ultimate which is controlled by Spectrum Aggregator.



Spectrotel is a Delaware limited liability company and is an indirect, wholly owned subsidiary of Spectrotel Services, LLC. It is headquartered at 3535 State Highway 66, Building 7, Neptune, NJ. 07753. Spectrotel received authorization to provide public telecommunications services in the State of Utah by the Commission on December 06, 2011, Docket No. 11-2543-01. Spectrotel is an indirect wholly owned subsidiary of Spectrotel Ultimate.

AireSpring is a Delaware corporation, headquartered at 600 Cleveland Street, Suite 226, Clearwater, Florida 33755. AireSpring received authorization to provide public telecommunications services in the State of Utah by the Commission on November 29, 2012, Docket No. 12-2560-01.

The Applicants state that under the terms of the agreement, Spectrotel Ultimate will acquire all the outstanding equity and voting interests in AireSpring. Through a series of corporate restructurings, Spectrotel Ultimate will be controlled by Spectrum Aggregator.

The Applicants submit that the transaction described herein will serve the public interest and that the transaction will be conducted in a manner that will be largely transparent to its customers. The transaction will not result in a change of carrier for customers or any assignment of authorizations, and in no event will it result in the discontinuance, reduction, loss, or impairment of service to customers.

Conclusion

The Division has reviewed the notice filed by the Applicants for the transfer of control and concludes that the Applicants are in compliance with Utah Admin. Code R746-349-7, and have provided reasonable documentation of the following:

2. The CLEC shall submit an application which includes but is not limited to:
 - a. Identification that it is not an ILEC,
 - b. Identification that it seeks approval of the application pursuant to this rule,
 - c. A reasonably detailed description of the transaction for which approval is sought,

- d. A copy of any filings required by the Federal Communications Commission or any other state utility regulatory agency in connection with the transaction, and,
- e. Copies of any notices, correspondence, or orders from any federal agency or any other state utility regulatory agency reviewing the transaction, which is the subject of the application.

The Division recommends the Commission acknowledge this notice.
