By The Commission:

A scheduling conference was held before the Commission, pursuant to notice in Docket No. 00-049-08, on August 20, 2001. Counsel for Qwest Corporation ("Qwest"), AT&T Communications of the Mountain States, Inc., XO Utah, Inc. and Electric Lightwave, Inc. were present in person or by telephone. In addition, the Division of Public Utilities appeared in its role as advisory staff in that docket.

The parties discussed procedures to facilitate the issuance of final reports of the Commission in Docket No. 00-049-08 and the scheduling of on-the-record technical conferences in Docket No. 00-049-08 to provide the Commission with information regarding Qwest's performance results, its post-entry performance assurance plan ("QPAP") and its operations support systems ("OSS") test results. During the course of the discussion, Qwest's modification of its Statement of Generally Available Terms and Conditions ("SGAT") in Docket No. 00-049-68 following issuance of Commission Reports in Docket No. 00-049-08 was also discussed. The parties to Docket No. 00-049-08 are also parties to Docket No. 00-049-68. The parties reached agreement on procedures and technical conferences in both dockets and presented their agreement to the Commission. The agreement of the parties is intended to supplement the procedural orders previously entered in both dockets and not to amend them.

The Commission having reviewed the proposed supplemental procedures and technical conferences and finding the same to be in the public interest now makes and enters this order adopting them.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

1. The procedures and schedule set forth in the Commission's prior procedural orders in these dockets shall remain in full force and effect. The procedures and schedule set forth in this Order are intended to supplement the procedures previously in effect.
2. With respect to Docket No. 00-049-08:
  - a. With respect to Staff Reports previously issued on Workshop 1 (Interconnection, Collocation, Number Portability, Reciprocal Compensation and Resale) and 2 (Emerging Services) on which the parties have previously filed comments:

i. Within 10 days of the date of this Order, parties may file proposed Commission Reports.

ii. If deemed useful by the Commission, the Commission may schedule oral argument on any or all issues remaining in dispute approximately 20 days following the date of this Order.

b. With respect to Staff Reports on Workshop 3 (Unbundled Network Elements) and Workshop 4 (Section 272, Track A, Public Interest and General Terms and Conditions):

i. Within 10 days following the date for filing comments on each Staff Report as provided in our prior procedural orders, any party may file a proposed Commission Report.

ii. If deemed useful by the Commission, the Commission may schedule oral argument on all or any issues in dispute approximately 20 days following the date the Staff Report is issued.

c. On-the-record technical conferences shall be held as follows:

i. Technical conferences shall be held commencing at 10:00 a.m. in Room 427, Heber M. Wells Building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah as follows:

September 17, 2001	Overview of Utah performance results
October 23, 2001	Update of Utah performance results
November 19, 2001	QPAP and update of performance results
OSS Test completion plus 10 days	OSS Test results and update of Utah performance results

ii. It is understood that the subject matter of the technical conferences following the technical conference scheduled for September 17, 2001, may be revised based upon subsequent direction from the Commission or agreement of the parties. For example, the parties are currently scheduled to file comments on the Staff Report on the QPAP on October 23, 2001. If that schedule holds, the Commission may determine or the parties may agree that the QPAP should be discussed at the technical conference on October 23, 2001 or a subsequent technical conference or that it would not be useful to hold a technical conference on the QPAP.

iii. If any party other than Qwest wishes to present performance data with respect to Qwest's performance in Utah, it shall do so during the course of the first three technical conferences scheduled. The foregoing sentence is not intended to modify prior orders entered in this docket regarding presentation of state-specific data.

iv. Any party that intends to utilize any handout or exhibit at any of the foregoing technical conferences shall provide a copy of the handout or exhibit to all parties in the docket by electronic mail at least two business days in advance of the technical conference.

v. Any party wishing to participate in any technical conference by telephone should notify Julie Orchard, Commission Secretary, at (801) 530-6713, at least one business day in advance of the technical conference.

3. With respect to Docket No. 00-049-68:

a. Qwest shall file a modified SGAT within 15 days of the date the Commission issues its Report in connection with any workshop in Docket No. 00-049-08.

b. Any party objecting to Qwest's modified SGAT on the basis that the modifications do not comply with the Commission's Report shall file its objection within 15 days of the date Qwest files its modified SGAT.

4.
