By the Commission:

On March 28, 2002, a Notice of Comment Period on Stipulation on Performance Assurance Plan was sent to the parties in this docket stating that comments on the proposed stipulation should be filed by April 8, 2002. On April 3, 2002, AT&T filed a Motion for Extension of Time to Respond to the Stipulation Between Advocacy Staff and Qwest Regarding Performance Assurance Plan. In its motion AT&T requested that it, and other parties, be given until April 10, 2002, to file comments on the proposed Stipulation. In its motion AT&T represents that all parties except Qwest have no objection to the extension. The motion indicated that Qwest had not responded to AT&T regarding the requested extension.

An extension of the time to file comments to April 10, 2002, is reasonable and appropriate. We will also extend by two days the time for Advocacy Staff and Qwest to respond to any filed comments.

All parties may file comments on the Stipulation up to and including Wednesday, April 10, 2002. If comments are filed on the Stipulation, Advocacy Staff and Qwest will have until Wednesday, April 17, 2002, to file responses.
